

Arran "Machrie Moor"

Aromatically, a judicious balance of Arran's seamless, fruity malt with the peat applied in soft brush strokes. Peat wise, it's more Highland than Island, the middle stage sweetness followed by a surge of pepper and sooty smoke before turning minty fresh. Spot-on balance, and packs a decent punch at 46% ABV with much more smoke than the nose suggests. A compelling alternative to entry level Islay. Non chill filtered.
