The beaming polished copper colour shows considerable legs. A thick, malty nose with attractive aromas of polished floorboards and damp cedar developing with fig jam, ripe apricot, hazelnut chocolate, soot and trace lanolin. Really dense. A chewy, oily delivery; lively spices fanning out with a burst of sooty peat. Drying, but keenly balanced with smoke and fresh oak rounding out the mid palate richness. A small amount of water draws out the latent fruitiness and sweetens the profile. Great stuff. Non chill filtered
