

Fettercairn Fionn Single Malt Scotch Whisky

Deep brass / gold; Offers a juicy, almost grape-like opening sniff with hints of gobstopper too. Second phase becomes drier and more subdued; now malt and cocoa. Unusually dry delivery - biscuity malt is evenly matched against drying oak with dustings of dark chocolate towards the finale. Concludes taut, lipsmackingly dry and with hints of oatmeal and honey into the fade. Beguiling whisky. Difficult to pin down. The peat isn't particularly evident. It's expressed in a more textural way contributing a subtle oily quality rather than overt flavour.
