

# Diageo's Flora and Fauna Range - Inchgower 14 Year Old

The nose is quite light and delicate. There is a zesty tang with notes of sugary citrus, hints of stemmy hay and a gentle breeze pushing barley in a Summer field. Tones of blossom and apple peel with cocoa. The palate is fresh with hay and petals, notes of arak and well-balanced tannins. There are some spicy notes with crystallized stem ginger. The finish is of medium length with spice and a tangy citrus note.
