

Kilchoman Machir Bay Single Malt Scotch Whisky

Pale straw colour with a water like hue. Powerful opening scents of lanolin like peat, brine and white pepper. Second pass brings out hints of ripe citrus peel. Several minutes' later fruit and nut chocolate comes to the fore. Typically complex. The palate is drier than the nose suggests, showing excellent concentration and lively spices. Citrus peel and dried fruit compete with lanolin and brine. Terrific balance. Concludes fresh, tangy, and mildly peppery with a subtle kippery aftertaste. Invigorating and impressive.
